VARIETY DETAILS



ORIGIN: UEB, Czech Republic



PARENTS: '3317/1' x 'Mira'



GROWTH: spreading, weak to medium vigor, optimal canopy structure, very well branched and garnished



HEALTHCHARACTER: tolerant to scab (Rvi6 + resistance on a polygenic basis) - very stable so far, very tolerant to mildew



BLOSSOM: medium flowering time with 'Jonagold' & 'Cox Orange', diploid



RIPENESS: Mid-September, about 10 days before 'Golden Delicious', ready to eat straight from the tree



APPEARANCE: medium-sized, flattened spherical; rarely slight radial russeting on the stalk; high proportion of overcolor (80-90%) dark red overcolor on yellow ground, flat, washed out



QUALITY: Flesh firm to medium firm, very crunchy, juicy



TASTECHARAKTER: pleasantly aromatic; sweet and sour taste, very good



CROPYIELD: early setting, medium to tall, uniform without alternate bearing



STORECHARACTER: in cold storage until March, in ULO (1.2°C, 1.2% O₂, 2.2% CO₂) min. 9 months



SPECIAL NOTES: no pre harvest fruit drop, no thinning necessary, wide harvest window, recommended starch degradation value 5-6 for long-term storage, tendency to greasiness if harvested too late
