



VARIETY DETAILS



ORIGIN: Agroscope, Switzerland



PARENTS: 'Topaz' x 'Fuji'



GROWTH: medium strong, very good branching



HEALTHCHARACTER: fire blight resistant, scab tolerant (scab resistant Rvi6), only low susceptibility to powdery mildew



BLOSSOM: medium-late flowering time, diploid, suitable pollinators are among others 'Topaz', Natyra® ('SQ159')



RIPENESS: Mid-September



APPEARANCE: medium size, globular, smooth skin, at minimum 3/4 red over colour



QUALITY: fruit flesh with fine texture, juicy, crunchy



TASTECHARAKTER: unusual, almost exotic aroma with a hint of lychee



CROPYIELD: early starting, good and regular yields



STORECHARACTER: marketing should be done by end of December



SPECIAL NOTES: if stored too long, noticeable loss of firmness and aroma, partial skin browning
