



VARIETY DETAILS



ORIGIN: JKI Dresden-Pillnitz, Germany



PARENTS: 'Krupnoplodaja' x 'Moldavskaja tschernaja'



GROWTH: medium strong growth with very good lateral branching



HEALTHCHARACTER: very robust variety



BLOSSOM: early, about 7 days before 'Regina', self-sterile, S alleles S1S9, good pollinators are among others: 'Christiana', 'Narana', 'Vanda', 'Paulus'



RIPENESS: 4th cherry week, about 14 days after 'Burlat'



APPEARANCE: kidney-shaped fruits, brown red coloured (CTIFL colour code 6), fruit size 30.9 mm, fruit weight 12.8 g, peduncle is long, green



QUALITY: high firmness 250,7 g/mm, juicy flesh, dark red coloured



TASTECHARAKTER: very good taste, aromatic with high sugar content (18.9% Brix) and low acidity (10.6g/l)



CROPYIELD: regular and high yields



SPECIAL NOTES: fruits are on short shoots and at the base of one-year-old branches
