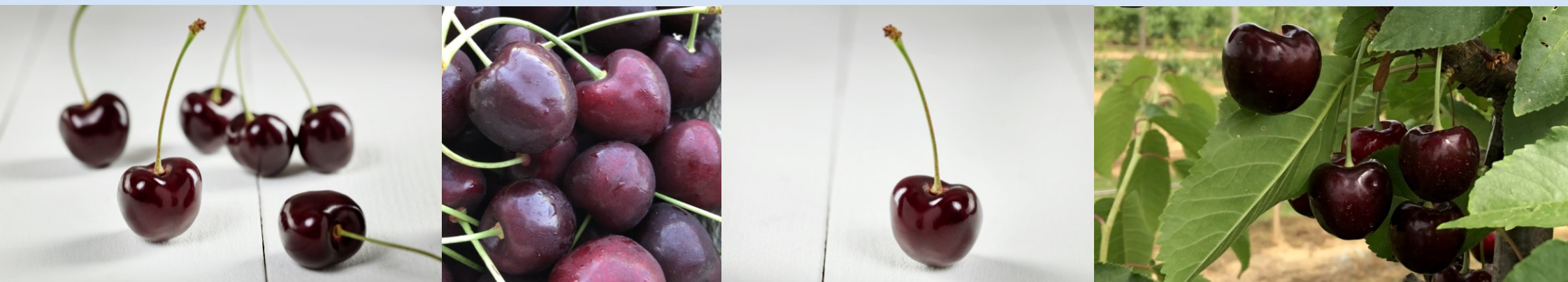

VARIETY DETAILS



ORIGIN: Müncheberg, Germany



PARENTS: free flowering of 'Kordia'



GROWTH: medium-strong, good branching, comparable to 'Regina'



BLOSSOM: late, strong flowering, S-alleles S1S3, good pollinators are among others 'Schneiders', 'Skeena', 'Kordia'.



RIPENESS: 6th-7th cherry week, between 'Kordia' and 'Regina'



APPEARANCE: dark-red, almost black, shiny fruit skin; heart-shaped, very attractive; stem long, not too thin and green, size 30 mm, average weight 13-15 g



QUALITY: flesh almost black, very firm (approx. 80+ Durofel 25), firm skin, juicy



TASTECHARAKTER: very flavoursome-aromatic taste, sugar content average 20+ Brix



CROPYIELD: high and regular, long harvest window



SPECIAL NOTES: no formation of clusters, thus good picking performance, slight bitter tone if harvested too early
