



## VARIETY DETAILS



**ORIGIN:** JKI Dresden-Pillnitz, Germany



**PARENTS:** 'Knauffs Schwarze' x 'Souvenir des Charmes'



**GROWTH:** medium strong and upright with very good branching, medium dense, compact canopy, easy spindle training



**BLOSSOM:** early, on average 4 days before 'Burlat', S-allele S2S9, good pollinators in comparable ripening time are among others: 'Rita', 'Souvenir des Charmes', 'Earlise®', 'Bellise®'



**RIPENESS:** 2nd cherry week, before/with 'Burlat'



**APPEARANCE:** the dark red fruits are round to flat-round, average 27-29 mm, medium long green stalk (36 to 40 mm), medium sized oval stone with 0,55g average weight



**QUALITY:** dark red to black-red coloured flesh, medium firmness (185 g/mm), cracking sensitivity is very low, about 10 g fruit weight



**TASTECHARAKTER:** excellent aromatic sweet, high sugar content of 17.2° Brix



**CROPYIELD:** regular and high (bears on 1- and 2-year-old wood)



**STORECHARACTER:** not suitable for long term storage or transport



**SPECIAL NOTES:** very low cracking sensitivity, easy to pick due to the length of the stems, caution in late frost threatened locations due to early flowering and pay attention to the right pollinators, alternative to 'Burlat' in direct marketing
