



VARIETY DETAILS



ORIGIN: NARIC, Hungary



GROWTH: quite strong growth, compact, very good branching



HEALTHCHARACTER: robust leaves and wood



BLOSSOM: medium-late - late, ideal to high flowering intensity, S alleles S6S12, good pollinators in the same ripening period are among others: 'Carmen', 'Early Korvik', 'Kordia'



RIPENESS: 5th Cherry Week, 20-25 days after 'Burlat', long harvest window



APPEARANCE: bicoloured large fruits (28-30 mm), kidney- or heart-shaped, green and thick stem, cream-coloured flesh



QUALITY: very firm (75/100 when fully ripe), crunchy and juicy flesh



TASTECHARAKTER: very good, aromatic with delicately balanced sugar-acid ratio, no bitter tones, 18° brix to full ripeness.



CROPYIELD: high and regular



SPECIAL NOTES: low susceptibility to bruising, no cluster formation, therefore high picking performance, very suitable for spindle cultivation, stems remain green for a long time after harvesting
