



VARIETY DETAILS



ORIGIN: JKI Dresden-Pillnitz, Germany



PARENTS: 'Kelleriis 16' x 'P10,17,5' ('Schattenmorelle' x 'Köröser')



GROWTH: medium strong and upright with good branching, flower bud formation mostly on one-year-old wood



HEALTHCHARACTER: healthy variety, very good tolerance to fungal leaf diseases, medium susceptibility to monilia laxa and monila fructigena



BLOSSOM: late flowering, self-fertile, medium sized and evenly spread flowers all over the tree



RIPENESS: late, 6th cherry week



APPEARANCE: medium sized dark red fruits (21-23 mm), medium long stem (31-50mm) with characteristic petioles



QUALITY: medium firm dark red flesh, deep dark red juice with very high anthocyanin content, 5.5 g average fruit weight, small easy to remove stone (0.3g)



TASTECHARAKTER: very good, balanced taste with strong fruit aroma, high content of total sugar (16% Brix), moderate acidity (18.3 g/l)



CROPYIELD: regular and medium high



SPECIAL NOTES: hardly any tendency to bare branches, well suited for spindle training, little risk of late frost damage, very suitable for mechanical harvesting as stems can be easily separated from fruit when fully ripe
