VARIETY DETAILS



ORIGIN: VSUO Holovousy, Czech Republic



PARENTS: 'Van' x 'Kordia'



GROWTH: medium growing, good leaf garnishing, medium branching



HEALTHCHARACTER: no problems with Pseudomonas



BLOSSOM: very early, S alleles S₃S₆, robust to late frost



RIPENESS: 3-4. cherry week



APPEARANCE: large, attractive fruits, with long stalk, dark red, when fully ripe black red, shiny, 26-28mm diameter, fruit weight 9 g



QUALITY: The skin is tender and fades quickly, the fruit is firm and has a fine, homogeneous fibre. Christiana® has good juiciness.



TASTECHARAKTER: Christiana® has a beautifully balanced sugar-acid ratio and impresses with its harmony. Flavours of green apple, dried banana and rose caress the palate.



CROPYIELD: high to very high, yield stable even in frost years (particularly frost-hardy)



SPECIAL NOTES: for an optimal yield, adequate fruit size and quality (fruits otherwise too soft) intensive pruning recommended, very burst-resistant even in very heavy rain, very high content of class extra
